



Let's Reflect on Today's Gospel... Luke 13:22-30

‘Sir, will there be only a few saved?’ How easy it is to distract ourselves from the real challenges by asking very interesting but ultimately irrelevant questions. Jesus’ reply points to what really matters: ‘Try your best to enter by the narrow door, because, I tell you, many will try to enter and will not succeed’. Am I ready to do what is right, even when it costs?

Jesus warns us of any false sense of entitlement: like the Jews, we too can feel too comfortable in the belief that God is somehow obliged to save us. What counts is not our past exploits or successes, but being with the Master at all times. I ask for humility and inner freedom.

THE WHAT'S NEXT SORORITY— (TWNS) An IRS approved 501©3 nonprofit organization

The What's Next Sorority (TWNS) is a free, confidential and professionally guided self-help/ peer support gathering for pregnant adolescent teens. Any pregnant girl between the ages of 12 to 19, living in the city of Rochester area is welcome! TWNS is conveniently located in the South Wedge neighborhood, which is easily accessible by bus via the Mt Hope and South Ave routes. The TWNS space is a comfortable, safe and welcoming environment for all who gather.

TWNS gathering's are held weekly on Tuesday evenings from 4:30pm until 7:00PM. We begin promptly at 4:30 with a time to socialize and enjoy a light snack. The confidential gathering sessions begin shortly after this. These sessions are designed to allow the sorority members an opportunity to freely share their experiences, knowledge, questions and concerns as well as their own individual, "What's next for me" hopes, dreams and goals for the future.

The What's Next Sorority's mission is to provide a fun and friendly atmosphere where each member has the opportunity to strengthen their normal, healthy development, which can sometimes be disrupted during the course of pregnancy. The goal is that through the formation of new friendships and the sharing and encouragement of peers, every girl will learn more about themselves and others as they navigate this very important time in their lives.

What makes TWNS unique is that our focus is primarily on the sorority member. Pregnancy at a young age can be a confusing and stressful time. Our hope is that by bonding together to offer strength and support to one another in a manner that includes surprises, gift cards, games and celebrations we can learn and grow together in a relaxed, fun atmosphere!
